But if you prefer just to tell time by using two hands, Victorinox Swiss Army offers a number of analog styles that are made with precision Swiss analog quartz movement. Buyer beware: Now you'll have no excuse to be late again. Swiss Army's Original (\$175; swissarmy.com) has a scratch-resistant crystal, a leather/nylon band, and is water-resistant up to 330 feet.
